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**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR NEET (UG) 2020**

**Attention to all candidates regarding admission to all India quota seats of AS & H Undergraduate Courses of Private I.M.& H. Medical Colleges for the academic year 2020-21.**

All the NEET-2020 Under-Graduate (BAMS/BSMS/BUMS / BHMS) aspirant candidates are hereby informed that Govt. of India, Ministry of AYUSH, New Delhi vide letter F.No.R.14011/2/2021-EP-1, dated 15.01.2021 has **reduced the required percentile criteria in NEET (UG) – 2020 in order to be eligible** for admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy (ASU&H) UG courses, due to various reasons.

The extract of the above letter is given hereunder;

**“.....in order to be eligible for admission in ASU&H UG Courses, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum marks at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in NEET-2020.**

**However, in respect of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at 30<sup>th</sup> percentile. In respect of candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum marks shall be at 35<sup>th</sup> percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) Category and 30<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC / ST / OBC.”**

In view of the above, it is informed that **candidates regarding admission to all India quota seats of AS & H Undergraduate Courses of Private I.M.& H. Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu** should check their eligibility and submit their filled-in applications to the Secretary, Selection Committee office, Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai – 106 on or before 30.01.2021 upto 05.30 p.m.

2	<b>AGE LIMIT :</b> As per amended regulations No candidate shall be admitted to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree Course unless one has attained the age of Seventeen Years on or before the 31 <sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission in the first year of the course and not more than of Twenty-Five years on or before the 31 <sup>st</sup> December of the year of admission in the first year of the course. Further, upper age limit is relaxed by five years in the case of <b>OBC(BC/BCM/MBC/DC) / SC/ST and Persons with Benchmark Disabilities</b> .
3	<b>EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:</b> <p>(i) In compliance to the amended rules &amp; regulations as effected by CCIM &amp; CCH with prior sanction of the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India through their Notifications on 10/12/2018 &amp; 17/12/2018 in the Gazette of India Extra ordinary respectively, the eligibility for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses for this academic year shall be based solely on marks obtained in the National Eligibility - cum - Entrance Test (NEETUG – 2020) conducted by NTA, New Delhi.</p> <p>(ii) In order to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses for this academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at <b>50<sup>th</sup> Percentile</b> in NEETUG-2020. However in respect of candidates belonging to OBC / SC / ST, the minimum marks shall be at <b>40<sup>th</sup> Percentile</b> in NEETUG-2020. In respect of candidates with <b>Persons with Benchmark disabilities</b> alone the minimum marks shall be at <b>45<sup>th</sup> Percentile</b> for General Category candidates and <b>40<sup>th</sup> Percentile</b> for OBC / SC / ST candidates in NEET UG-2020.</p> <p>(iii) Further, to be eligible for admission to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Degree courses, Candidates must have passed in all the subjects of the qualifying examination of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (Academic) conducted by Any State Board or any other equivalent Board with the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology and English individually and must have obtained minimum of <b>fifty percent</b> of marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology at the aforesaid qualifying examination in the case of general category and <b>forty percent</b> mark in the case of OBC / SC / ST category. In respect of <b>Persons with Benchmark disabilities</b> candidates the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Botany and Zoology shall be <b>forty five percent</b> in the case of general category and <b>forty percent</b> in the case of OBC / SC / ST.</p> <p>(iv) <b>Language qualification for BSMS Course</b> In addition to the required minimum percentile in the <b>NEETUG-2020</b></p> <p><b>a)</b> The candidate should have studied in Tamil medium up to X or XII Standard, or</p>

	<p>b) The candidate should have studied Tamil as a subject up to X or XII Standard, or</p> <p>c) The candidate must be prepared to pursue the study of Tamil Language as a subject during the First professional course of B.S.M.S. course, to become eligible to take the other subjects examination of the BSMS Course.</p> <p><b>NOTE:-</b> Candidates who have passed any other equivalent examinations with same subjects as mentioned above in clause 3 (iv) should produce the eligibility certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University before the counselling date or before attending the counselling.</p>
4	<p><b>INELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :</b></p> <p>The following categories of candidates are <b>NOT ELIGIBLE</b> to apply for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses.</p> <p>a. Candidates who have passed H.Sc. in Vocational Stream and private candidates, or who have passed Pre-University Course or candidates who have passed through Open Schooling.</p> <p>b. The selection and admission of candidates of other Universities / Boards will be provisional subject to recognition of the qualifying examination by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University under which the candidate gets admitted. In case, the recognition is not accorded for the admission of the candidate on any grounds, the provisional admission will not entitle the candidate for the continuance of the course and the admission will be cancelled.</p> <p>c. 6	<p><b>DURATION OF THE BSMS / BAMS / BHMS COURSES:</b></p> <p>5 1/2 years of study including one year Compulsory Rotatory Resident Internship.</p>
7	<p><b>METHOD OF SELECTION AND ADMISSION:</b></p> <p>(i). The admission shall be made on the basis of National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test <b>NEET UG-2020</b> score for B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses for the year 2020 - 21 for the Seats under All India Quota in Self Financing IM &amp; H Medical Colleges.</p> <p>(ii). Rank List of the eligible candidates shall be prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in <b>NEET UG-2020</b>. Further Secretary, Selection Committee will publish the tentative rank list on the following official website : <a href="http://www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in">www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in</a> and candidates shall be admitted to the above courses from the said rank list <b>ONLY</b>.</p>
8	<p>All selections and admissions for BSMS / BAMS / BHMS Courses are only provisional. The Selection and admission is liable to be cancelled at any time as and when the eligibility conditions are found to be defective or incorrect or of any suppression of facts deliberately or otherwise. The right of allotment to BSMS / BAMS / BHMS courses and Colleges is vested totally with the Selection Committee.</p>

- (i). Candidates should attend the counselling session as per the schedule and as per their rank with call letter downloaded from the official website : [www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in](http://www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in) only.
- (ii). One of the Parents or Guardian will be allowed to accompany the candidate to attend the counselling and they should make their own arrangements for attending the counselling session. Also use of Mobile Phones will be strictly prohibited in the Counselling Hall.
- (iii) Candidates will be called for counselling as per their rank and they may exercise their option as per their eligibility norms mentioned in the Prospectus.
- (iv) Option once exercised during counselling, will be final and cannot be changed.
- (v) Candidates who fail to attend the counselling at the specified date and time will forfeit their right to admission and their names will not be considered later. However he / she can authorize his / her parent on his / her behalf for that phase of counselling due to unavoidable circumstances like Covid Positive and the parent's decision will be binding on the candidate. - (vi) Seat under All India Quota (AIQ) will be open in nature and there shall not be any requirement for domicile in a particular State / UT or passing of 10+2 in a particular State / UT.
- (vii) Rules as applicable for the All India Quota seats as per the prevalent CCIM / CCH rules and regulations, State Policy and the relevant rules of institutions applicable to the Self Financing All India Quota will apply.
- (viii)(a). All Communications regarding Counselling will be displayed / available through the official website only and any change or modification and relevant information pertaining to this admission process will be made available immediately on the website [www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in](http://www.tnhealth.tn.gov.in).
- (b). The candidates are instructed to visit the website at least two times a day for updates from the date of release of application till the end of admission process without fail. Selection Committee will not be responsible for consequences resulting due to non-diligent follow-up of notices, notification and publications appearing on the website regarding admission to B.S.M.S. / B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. Courses under All India Quota 2020-21 session.
- (ix) (a). Candidates can exercise their option for the course and the college of their own choice at the time of counselling, and allotment is subject to availability of seats.
- (b). Individual request for transfer of College or change of course will not be allowed after allotment of seat is made.
- (x) The vacancies arising after the All India Quota Counselling will be converted into State Quota and it will be filled by the State Government as per rules and policies of Govt. of Tamil Nadu.
- (xi) Mutual transfers will not be allowed under any circumstances.
- (xii) The candidate is eligible to opt for any of the courses viz. BSMS / BAMS / BHMS course under All India Quota in Self-financing colleges based on his/her eligibility and merit marks obtained in NEET 2020.
- (xiii) Those who obtained allotment order to a particular course in a Self Financing college under All India Quota during the counselling do not join within the stipulated time to that particular course and college to which they are allotted, will not be considered for admission at any point of time later.
- (xiv) Counselling schedule will be made available on the website only.

**(xv) COVID INSTRUCTION :-**

The candidates and their parents are instructed to follow the standard preventive measures to reduce the risk of COVID-19 during the counselling which includes:

- i. Either of the parent / guardian will alone be permitted along with the candidate inside the counselling hall.
- ii. Every person being permitted inside the counselling hall shall be subject to the thermal screening and oxygen saturation without any exemption.
- iii. Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible.
- iv. Use of face covers/masks to be made mandatory.
- v. Frequent hand washing with soap (for at least 40-60 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.
- vi. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- vii. Self-monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest.
- viii. Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
- ix. Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App may be advised wherever feasible.

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**TUITION FEES:**

**The Tuition Fees for BSMS, BAMS and BHMS courses under All India Quota in Self Financing Medical Colleges shall be collected as fixed by the Hon'ble Justice N.V.Balasubramanian Committee for the fixation of Fee for Self - Financing Professional Educational Institutions for the year 2020-2021.**

**Any modification in the Fee structure for the academic year 2020-2021 as fixed by the Fee Fixation Committee will be intimated at the time of counselling / Admission.**

- (a) Detailed information regarding Tuition Fees, Special Fees, Caution Deposit, Scholarship, Fee Concession, Hostel Facilities, University Registration Fees, Curriculum Examination Fees, etc. can be obtained from the Head of the Institution in which the candidate joins.

- (b) All the candidates attending IM & H UG courses counselling for All India Quota seats will have to remit a non-refundable amount of **Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) through SBI Collect facility and submit the details regarding the SBI collect transaction ID and the original receipt for the same compulsorily as processing fee for Counselling before signing attendance register** meant for participating in the counselling. The procedure of online payment is mentioned in Clause 25 of this prospectus.
- (c) The candidates who are selected at the time of counselling ( Under All India Quota Seats in Self-Financing IM & H College ) shall remit a refundable sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) through SBI Collect facility and submit the details regarding the SBI collect transaction ID and the original receipt for the same compulsorily at the time of receipt of the allotment orders.** After the conduct of **Registration Subcommittee meeting** by the Tamil Nadu Dr.MGR Medical University this amount will be transferred to the Self Financing Medical Colleges concerned to get adjusted against the Tuition Fees to be paid by the candidates. **If the candidate fails to join the course after getting allotment order under All India Quota Seats within the stipulated time he/she will forfeit this amount and the seat allotted.**
- (d) If any amount - remains due from the student as a result of revision of fees if any, it shall be payable by the student. An undertaking to pay any amount that may become due as and when the fee structure is revised should be given to the Head of Institution at the time of Admission.

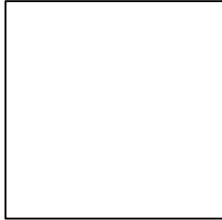

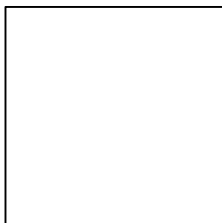


